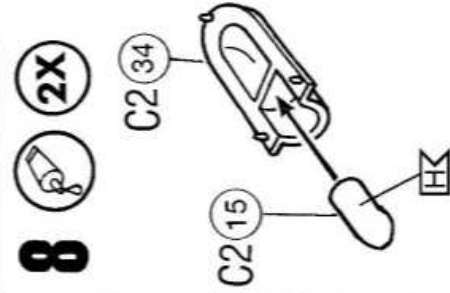
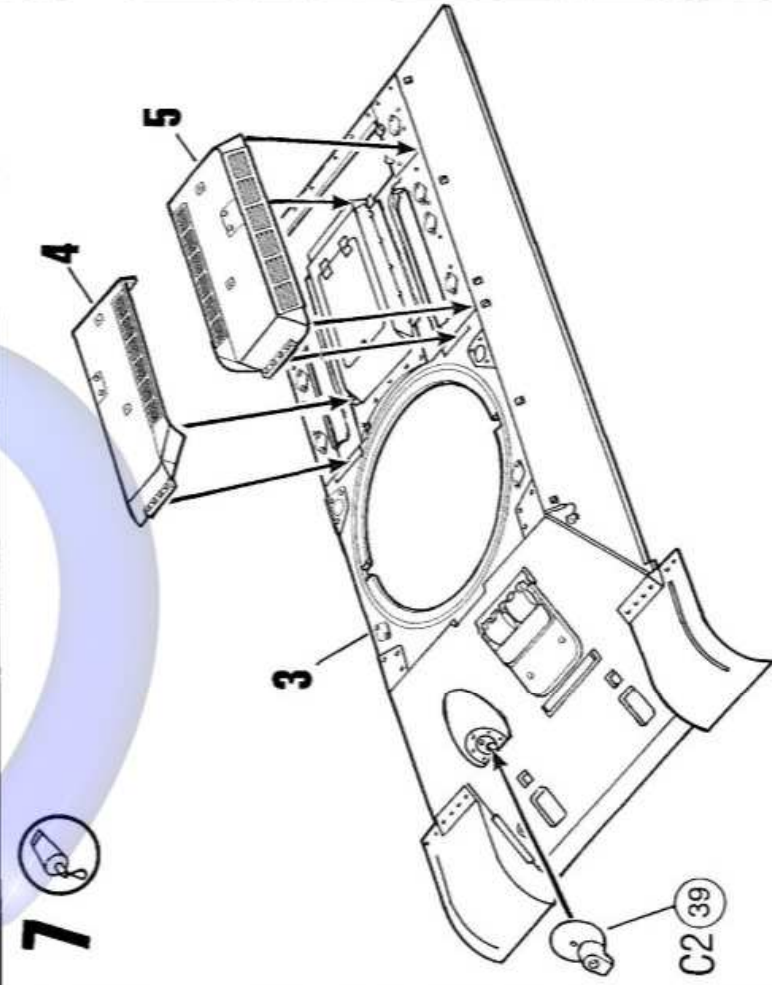
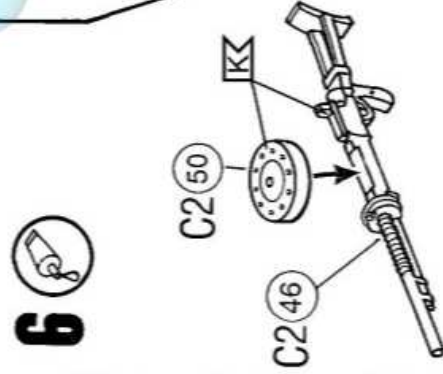
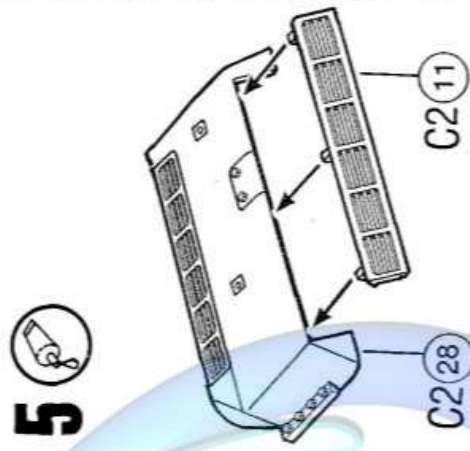
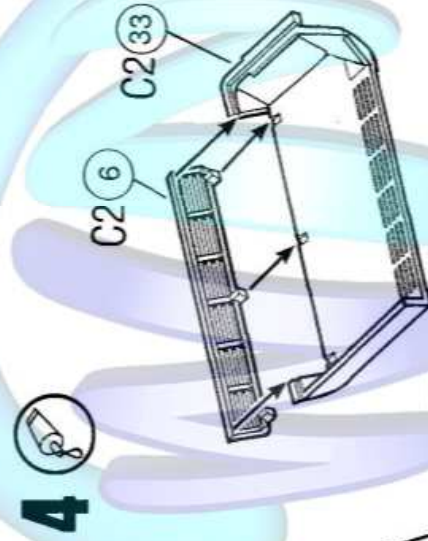
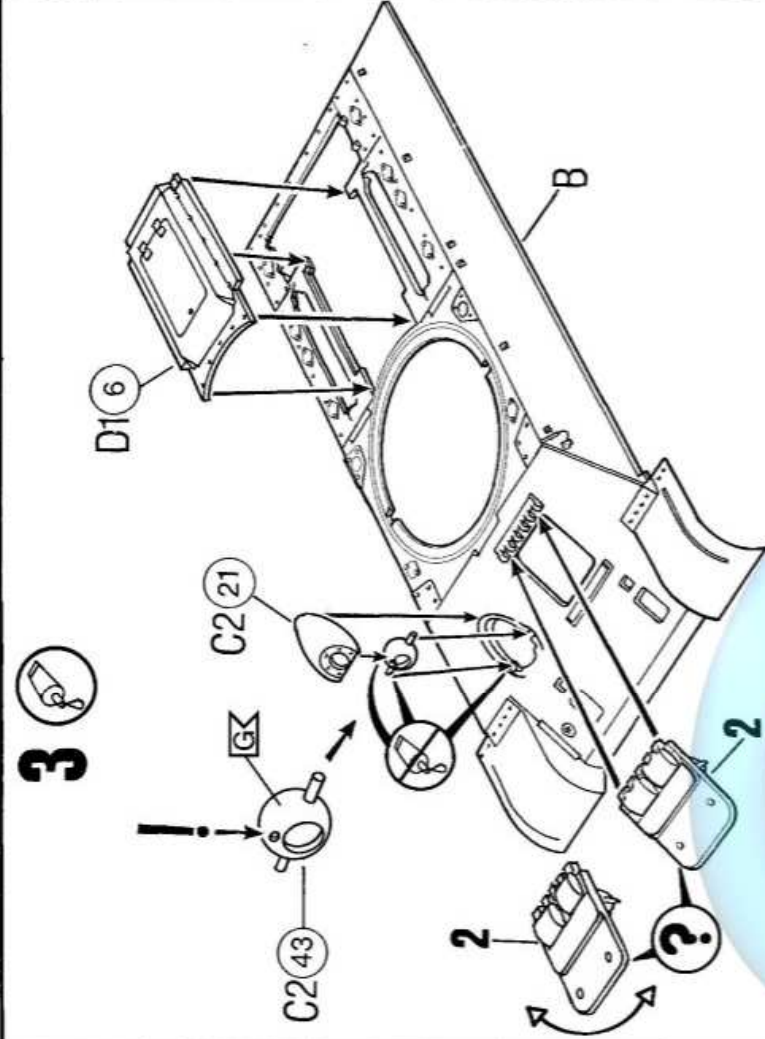
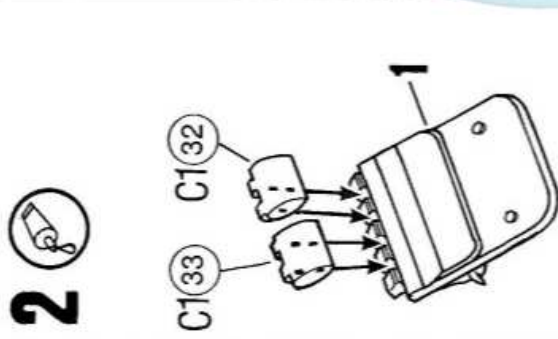
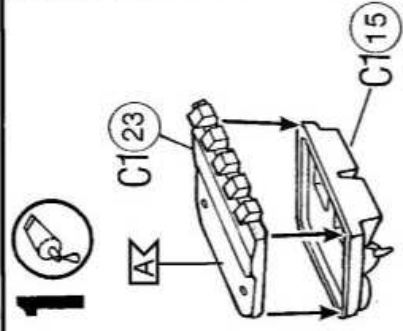
Der russische Kampfpanzer T-34 war zu Beginn des Russlandfeldzuges ein Schock für die deutschen Truppen. Er verband auf perfekte Weise Beweglichkeit mit Panzerungsschutz und Feuerkraft. Das Modell 1943 war mit einer 76,2 mm F-34-Kanone und einem Munitionsvorrat von 100 Schuss ausgestattet. Das Gewicht betrug 31 Tonnen und der Motor leistete 500 PS, was eine Geschwindigkeit von bis zu 55 km/h ermöglichte. Zwischen 1940 und 1944 wurden insgesamt über 35.000 T-34/76 gebaut. Erst mit den Panzerentwicklungen Panther und Tiger konnte die Wehrmacht dem T-34 etwas entgegensetzen.

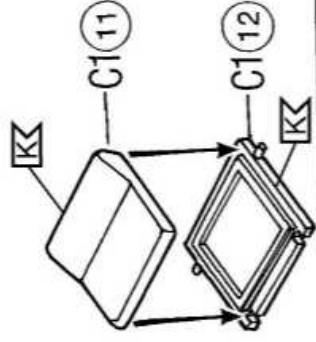
At the beginning of the Russian campaign the Russian T-34 Main Battle Tank came as a shock to German troops. It combined mobility with armour protection and firepower in an almost perfect way. The 1943 model features a 76.2 mm F-34 main armament and 100 rounds of ammunition. Its weight was 31 tonnes and its engine delivered 500 bhp enabling a maximum speed of 55 km/h (33 mph). Between 1940 and 1944 a total of 35,000 T-34/76's were built. The German Wehrmacht could only counter the T-34 after the Panther and Tiger tanks were developed and entered service.
